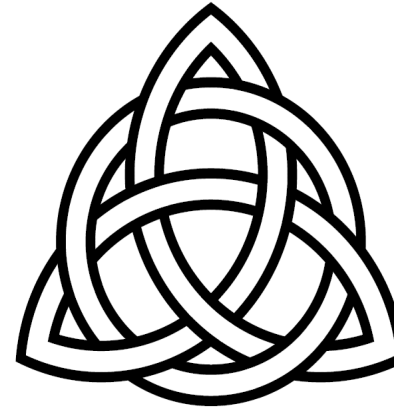

Last year Hillsborough Parish helped East Belfast Mission with their Neighbours in Need Christmas hamper project. Over 365 hampers were distributed to vulnerable families in East Belfast and throughout the city – almost double the number of hampers as the year before. With the effects of the financial downturn impacting local families more than ever, this year the number of hamper requests is expected to grow.
