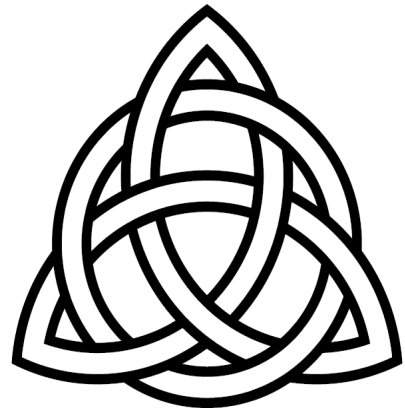

Last year Hillsborough Parish helped East Belfast Mission with their Neighbours in Need Christmas hamper project. With the effects of the financial downturn impacting local families more than ever, this year the number of hamper requests is expected to grow.
